

As previously stated in my other complaints, Wells Fargo massacred me with crime. I have an air tight case. I suffer horrifically every day, and my suffering is harder and harder to endure as time goes on. I am under terrible financial stress, and I have an extreme overreaction to stress, as part of my condition. Wells Fargo disabled me to the point that I cannot make an income. My missing income has left a major gap in my life. When Wells Fargo does this to me and then doesn't want to be a part of the solution, Wells Fargo leaves a gap that is too big for anyone else to fill.

I need the US DOJ to do right and to help me. I have submitted a complaint about dozens and dozens of felonies that have been committed against me. I sent to several authorities, and none have helped me yet. The massacre that I have been dealt is too severe. I cannot get up and go on my own. It is such that I need someone's help. Please have them at least return my emails. I would like to speak with them.

I am a kindhearted man and a team player. I have spoken to the US DOJ in a demeaning way many times. I have gotten angry and yelled. I have brow beaten the US DOJ about their mistakes. All of this may have left the wrong impression with the US DOJ. I can help the US DOJ in its outcome. We can work together and get a solution that works for everyone. I would see the US DOJ in a whole new light, and Wells Fargo too.
