

## 6/13/2019 Appointment

On **6/7/2019**, I call in and tell the nurse that I've upped my Adderall, because I am in having emotional trauma that is causing me to be unable to work.

On the **6/13/2019** appointment, at the beginning of the appointment, I start to play her the recorded call with Shirley. I tell her how Shirley is asking for my social security number, and that this is suspect. I tell her how Shirley is calling me from Davidson, NC. I tell her how Jenny told me to call Shirley, because Shirley had left a voicemail on Jenny's **work** number, **which I do not even know**. I tell her that we need to set up a sting. Kathy isn't interested in any of this and will not listen to the rest of the call. She says that she thinks that "Shirley is just doing her job."

I tell Kathy about the Mobile Crisis counselor being Jenny's personal friend. I tell Kathy about the crisis counselors' suspect behavior. I tell her how one of the counselors repeatedly asked me, loudly and with great emphasis, "do you have a mental illness? What we need to know is do you have a mental illness?" I tell Kathy that I looked it up, and the Charlotte Mecklenburg Police officer has committed a crime and the punishment is 3 years in prison.

I tell her how I am disabled and how I just sit there and "melt" at my home, and how I am unable to get anything done. I describe this horrible emotional trauma that I am under. I tell her how taking 60 mg Adderall instead of 40 mg helps me function enough that I can get work done, sometimes. During May, there had been just a few days where I could get work done, if I took extra Adderall.

I brought it up, again, how the social worker at the inpatient unit refused to deauthorize or delete Jenny's number and my mother's number.

Near the end of the appointment, I tell Kathy that I'm going to file a lawsuit against Wells Fargo, over the privacy violation.
