8:40 – still pacing a lot, not pacing as much

9:10 – since this traumatic stress has intensified, I'm pacing all the time

9:40 – hyperarousal consists of vigilance and irritability

10:05 – Depersonalization

10:10 – I think I am better when I'm not

10:50 – Depersonalization

11:32 – have detached feeling, accompanied by a feeling of hostility or cruelty

12:15 – I tell her that I have chronic PTSD per John

12:47 – I feel like if you put someone who is a prisoner of war next me in, with brain scans, I would be as bad or worse

13:05 – If I can be totally without stress, that life is more tolerable. I am extremely sensitive to stress. If I get a burst of stress, it takes me from being kind of wrecked, to really wrecked for days

13:38 – I missed a bunch of deadlines with my bankruptcy

15:10 – mention being kidnapped

15:45 – that was an acute stress

16:05 – I was so disabled that I couldn't fill out my exemption forms.

16:45 – I am going to turn my paperwork in on 2/24/2024. Driving is out of the question.

17:40 – I print out my pdfs

18:05 – I'm screaming and crying in the courtroom

19:01 – I'm disabled and unable to do this

19:20 – you've never seen me like this. I am screaming and crying in the courtroom

19:59 – I mention a kidnapping

20:10 – I bring up the petition

20:35 – the time I was taken into custody is 11:43 pm. The time I am delivered to the examination unit is also 11:43 pm

21:20 – I ask about dark skinned

23:00 – I ask about who entered the times

23:20 – the officer admitted that he didn't have the petition in his possession

23:45 –

25:10 – I mention the kidnapping again

25:15 – I ask if Atrium dropped the ball

25:20 – Kathy changes the subject to “is your medication working?”

25:30 – I tell her that I take 10 mg zyprexa

27:40 –

28:54 – Zyprexa knocks me out

29:20 – I ask her about her comment “relates things back to himself”

30:11 –

30:20 – I ask her if it is a fair statement to say that I'm not delusional, in regards to what I think about Jenny and this Shirley lady

31:30 – I start to talk about mobile crisis “they tell me that I need to eat a cheeseburger and to read a book, and I've had a bad day” “their internal records have me as being severely paranoid, and a bunch of stuff...an acute psychosis” I have reported these people to the FBI.

32:11 – she asks if I reported the mobile crisis to the FBI

32:31 – I say that Jenny is the frontrunner of Wells Fargo's scams. She is so eager for the crisis people to come visit me. Jenny says that “Allie went to the magistrate with me.”

34:20 – Mobile crisis is involved in this involuntary commitment

34:40 – this was a kidnapping,

34:45 – the officer commits a civil trespass, civil battery, false imprisonment, and kidnaps me by transporting to the inpatient unit. He has met every element of the crime of kidnapping. I am sure that the kidnapping falls under the jurisdiction of the FBI.

37:00 – she keeps interrupting me saying “do you have a mental illness”

38:14 – Is it fair to say that I am attuned to reality?

39:00 – is it a fair statement that I am attuned to reality

39:30 – she asks if I'm asking if she thinks I'm psychotic

40:15 – Thought or feeling of wanting to die is extremely acute, I get hit with depersonalization.

41:20 – I ask if I'm psychotic at all

41:40 – she says I've been very talkative

43:30 – she cannot say if I'm in an acute psychosis
