

-I was kidnapped. It is not what you normally think of as a kidnapping. It was done under the guise of a civil commitment petition

-I was having PTSD symptoms as early as February 2019

-I had profound PTSD symptoms in April 2019.

-My PTSD symptoms became extremely profound in May 2019

-I moved from the mountains of western N.C. to Charlotte in 2011. I left behind a big mess. This included people who made attempts on my life. I was stigmatized and horrible rumors went around about my mental health history.

-An idiot Wells Fargo senior manager, who didn't get along with me, has a girl look into my past. This is a civil intrusion upon seclusion

-I make legal threats and this prompts a massive crime wave on the part of Wells Fargo

-In April 2019, e and this girl Jenny start arguing about this situation. She repeatedly says it never happened, but there are too many suspect details that make it clear to me that it has.

-I made a heated comment about "don't have nobody come over here to get me because I'm going to be a vegetable". I was making a reference to what would happen if I poisoned myself and she sent someone over here to get me.

-Jenny uses this heated statement as an excuse to fill out a civil commitment petition with the magistrate in Charlotte.

-The privacy violation that I said had occurred was entered on the civil commitment petition as that I "thought my friends are out to get me" and that I was having paranoid delusions.

-The petition says that I have detailed plans to commit suicide

-I describe an officer of the Charlotte Mecklenburg police taking actions against my consent

-On the way there, the officer makes it clear that he is not in possession of the petition

-I was very eager and anxious to see a doctor because this whole thing is very transparently bullshit

-The guy at the door and the police officer have an exchange about "we will make them the same. That way we can say that we put the wrong time."

-When I got the petition in January, I discovered what they were talking about. The time I am taken into custody and the time I was delivered to the unit were both entered as 11:43pm

-the police officer was Jenny's neighbor

-The purpose of this is to provide plausible deniability over the fact that the officer was not in possession of the petition when he was at my residence. They know that they can't put the real time because the magistrate's audit file will show that he could not have gotten the petition at 11:35 and then picked me up at 11:03.

-The reason this was a kidnapping was because under north Carolina law, the civil commitment petition in his possession is what gives him the right to come into my residence, put me in handcuffs, and transport me against my will.

-The actions the officer took were carried out as part of a series of healthcare frauds

-I find out that Wells Fargo was behind the petition

-There was potentially another girl involved in the privacy violation

-I never had plans detailing suicide. I made a heated statement

-A crisis counselor came with Jenny to the magistrate's office

-The crisis counselors were paid to create a fraudulent healthcare record

-At that time, I had a very, very lengthy history of being very stable

-There is very clearly not a damn thing wrong with me

-Jenny insisted that I talk to the crisis counselors. It was a little suspect that this is a number that Jenny provides, because Jenny is up to no good. At this point, I don't know what the hell to think of Jenny.

-Of the 2 crisis counselors, one listens to my narrative, the other is focused on only 2 questions- do you have a mental illness and what is your diagnosis.

-The crisis counselors tell me that I just need to eat a cheeseburger and play on my computer. When I retrieve their notes, the notes say that I am paranoid, delusional, live in a malodorous apartment, I'm covered in sweat inside a cool apartment, and that I am overweight.

-I come to novant health because they are not Atrium Health

-My brain doesn't know what's legal and what's not

-I've got people that want to kill me in the mountains.

-This thing at work caused me unbelievable, horrible stress.

-There is no legal right conveyed by a known to be fraudulent petition.

-If you make a threat of suicide, there has to be a reasonable probability that you will end your life

-The officer knew the petition was fraudulent

-After I am sent to Atrium, the destruction of my life follows.

-The people at Atrium are rabid, foaming at the mouth criminals. They have been criminally victimizing me since then

-April Morciglio was likely part of the scam. She wouldn't listen to a damn word that I say.

-Despite my claims to the contrary, the people at Atrium conclude that there's not a damn thing wrong with me.

-After my hospital calls bullshit on their petition, Wells Fargo is sweating bullets over what my hospital may have on them, on their records. Wells Fargo knows that Wells Fargo has committed a slew of crimes. The finance lady at Atrium starts to make fraudulent attempts to get my healthcare records and send them to Wells Fargo.

-I have a fear of abuse of the mental health system. I told her this in the appointment and I sent her an email
