I picture it as sounding completely insane that I mention these figures that I do. I also get a feeling like that you think I'm up to something nefarious. I can imagine this impression being created. I have had this feeling for a long time, the feeling that you think I'm being anything but honest with you. It is a mistake if you care at all about what's right.

I speak the literal truth that I see and what I think. I do this extremely reliably. There are not many exceptions. I place an irrational value on truth and honesty, I think. Most others do not act as I do as it relates to this.

The way my life is designed is that everything confirms what I say, in the end. I have very accurate perceptions and very accurate intuitions. I am careful and scientific in my thinking and I put a lot of effort into saying things that are accurate (saying things that are accurate is a very hard thing to do. It is so incredibly easy to be wrong, to jump to conclusions, etc. I've caught myself doing this a lot in the past about 2 or 3 months. I'm still above the bar.) I speak so much truth and I'm right such a huge percentage of the time. My version of what's happened and everything about my life will be vetted. It is inevitable.

If I get some credible experts on this, they will confirm that \$10 billion is pennies on dollar. I will have a consensus among many that this is the case. I will get gratification out of having been right the whole time. They will confirm that it was the actions of Wells Fargo and the various entities that Wells Fargo induced into criminal behavior that caused this profound injury to my brain and the related PTSD. I still get the sense that Wells Fargo is trying to deny this, as ridiculous as that is.

You do not realize the extent to which you have ruined a human being. I am so profoundly broken and injured. The best thing and the most appropriate thing for me is to be put to death.

I get the sense that Wells Fargo still thinks it's game on and that they're playing tactics in the background. It's like it's the same fight and the same situation that we've been on the whole time. If it is brought to the public's awareness just how badly you have ruined a human being, it just may be a game changer. It is a terrible, terrible thing.
