This is a freaking mess. I am going to be destroyed by it, but I'm almost certainly going to have to make adjustments to the amount that I want and/or the timing that I get it. It will hurt so bad. Maybe I get some of my payout deferred and the timing will be tied to some index or on some economic metric that has to be met. I want to die just thinking about it. It is such cruelty.

I can tell you that if we were in a theoretical system where I could have a fair trial and that LA Times signal history was intact to be subpoenaed, you would have a lot on your hands. I would get such a massive judgment.

I will likely move to another country. I'm not sure. Losing my privacy and being widely known in this country will be a massive blow that will be very hard to take. There will be an upside. I will accumulate some fans and I'll have plenty of people to talk to. But it will still cause me such pain. If I decide to help the bank, I can do it from my new country remotely. And I hate the thought of this. I've got how to live and how to go about things figured out pretty good in this country, and I can't stand the thought of changing things up. In some countries, like Australia, a lot of the books aren't sold in a hardcover edition. They do this because people elsewhere aren't as rich as we are, presumably. I like hardcover books.

I don't know if the bank wants me to help them. I don't know to what extent I could help them. I don't know to what extent I want to help them either. I think me being part of the bank is part of all of our way out of this, however. I will do whatever I can to help the country, even if I move. If it is a situation where the bank will take too big a blow to reasonably get up from, unless I help them somehow, for sure I want to help them. I would hate to see this bank fall any further than it has already fallen. It is overall a great bank with great people. It also has some people who have done me terribly wrong.

I will think of how I can adjust my offer for a while. In the relatively near term future, I will make some audios where I share some of my ideas for how to smooth this over with the public. A big component of what we do needs to be that Wells Fargo comes out better at the end of this. The way to approach that is to make a plan and do an assessment such that Wells Fargo is in fact better off. This is as opposed to using a PR Gimmick or playing a game of appearances. If we face skepticism, we have to defend ourselves, and it is the easiest thing on earth to defend something that is factually the case. In the process of defending yourself to one person, you will have everyone else believing you too. Your case is compelling because it is real. If you can communicate that to people in a way that they can understand, they will not have a shred of doubt.

I'm thinking about this, and I think I'll stay in this country no matter what. I don't know how to adjust my offer but I'll think about it. What we're not going to do is cause a shit storm or do anything else that will irritate this situation that is being called a "crisis."
